Fort Wayne Recycling Facility Information

The City's Yard Waste Recycling Facility located at 6202 Lake Avenue has begun their summer hours from 8am-6pm Monday-Saturday and 12pm-6pm on Sundays. Visitors can pick up biosolids and mulch for gardening and landscaping projects.

Biosolids and mulch are free if customers load the material themselves. Customers purchasing a ton or more of biosolids will be charged \$8 for each ton. Customers purchasing less than a ton will pay \$5.

The facility also accepts yard waste, grass clippings, twigs, and small brush. The cost is \$1 for the first 250lbs and \$17 per ton prorated after the first 250lbs. Railroad ties, treated lumber, and concrete are not accepted.
